Page 1 - CREATION & rebellion of SIN: 6 days, PROMISE of the SEED & master desires

*JEWISH DAY begins & ends at SUNDOWN... **EVENING & MORNING***

Gen 1:5 God called the light day & the darkness He called night.
...evening & there was morning, one day.

Important to understand A DAY to understand what Jesus said in Matthew 12:40

Mat 12:40 ...as Jonah was 3 DAYS & 3 NIGHTS in the belly of the...
so will the Son of Man be 3 DAYS & 3 NIGHTS in the heart of the earth.

SIX (6) LITERAL days (*Yom is the word used, a literal 24 hr day*)

Gen 1:31 God saw all that He had made... the sixth day.

God said it & if He could create it in 6, he could have done in any time!
However, HE used SIX DAYS to set a pattern for us. BELIEVE the WORD!

God created MALE and FEMALE

Gen 1:27 God created man in His own image... male & female He created them.

COMMANDED US to be fruitful, MULTIPLY & FILL the earth, subdue it.

Gen 1:28 God said, "Be fruitful & multiply & fill the earth & subdue it;
Gen 2:24 For this reason...be joined to his wife & they shall become one flesh.

ONE COMMAND, woman deceived, man rebelled = Sin, KNOWING GOOD & EVIL

Gen 2:17 from the tree of the knowledge of good & evil you shall not eat

Gen 3:1 Now the serpent was more crafty

Gen 3:5 For God knows that ... you eat from it your eyes will be opened

Gen 3:6 she gave also to her husband with her & he ate.

Gen 3:13 the woman said, "The serpent deceived me & I ate."

THE PROMISE OF THE SEED OF THE WOMAN - the hope of the firstborn!

Gen 3:15 enmity Between you & the woman, between your seed & her seed;
He(JESUS) shall bruise you on the head & you shall bruise him on the heel

Gen 3:16 To the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply Your pain in childbirth
...your desire will be for your husband & he will rule over you."

Gen 3:17 To Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your
wife & have eaten from the tree... Cursed is the ground because of you;
In toil you will eat of it..."

*KNOWING GOD & EVIL isn't good because our flesh desires pleasure
and some pleasure is evil. GOD PROTECTED US FROM EVERLASTING LIFE IN SIN*

Gen 3:22 The Lord said, "man has become like one of Us, knowing good & evil;
he might ...take also from the tree of life & eat & live forever"

Gen 3:23 therefore the Lord God sent him out from the garden of Eden

CAIN warned...see Genesis 4, sin's desire is real, but we must master it.

Gen 4:7 ...sin... its desire is for you, but you must master it."

Page 2 - FLOOD & the NATIONS: Enoch, Noah, Shem, Ham & Japheth - forced to scatter

ENOCH "raptured", μετέθηκεν (metetheken) - transferred... "walked with God".

Gen 5:23 So all the days of Enoch were 365 years.

Gen 5:24 Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

MORE THAN WICKEDNESS, it was an attack on the "seed" of the woman

Gen 6:4 The Nephilim were on the earth...sons of God (**demons**) came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them. Gen 6:5 Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth ...every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. Gen 6:6 The Lord was sorry that He had made man... was grieved in His heart. Gen 6:7 The Lord said, "I will blot out man...from man to animals...

Gen 6:8 But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord.

Gen 6:10 Noah became the father of three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Gen 6:11 the earth was corrupt... & the earth was filled with violence.

Gen 6:13 Then God said to Noah... I am about to destroy them with the earth.

Gen 6:15 length of the ark 300 cubits, breadth 50 cubits & height 30 cubits.

Gen 6:16 a window...a cubit from the top; a lower, 2nd & 3rd decks.

Gen 6:17 flood of water upon the earth... destroy all ...the breath of life

The FLOOD covered the earth for about one year. (they were on the ark for 371 days!)

Gen 9:1 God blessed Noah & sons... "Be fruitful & multiply, and fill the earth.

Gen 9:3 Every moving thing that is alive shall be food for you;...

Gen 9:4 Only you shall not eat flesh with its life, that is, its blood.

Gen 9:7 be fruitful & multiply; Populate the earth abundantly & multiply in it.

Gen 9:13 I set My bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a sign of a covenant

Gen 9:15 I will remember My covenant & never shall the water destroy all flesh.

SIN OF HAM, CURSE on CANAAN - BLESSING OF SHEM and JAPHETH

(We are descendants of JAPHETH; Israel of SHEM; Ham: Canannites cursed)

Gen 9:22 Ham...father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father & told...

Gen 9:23 But Shem & Japheth took a garment... walked backward & covered

Gen 9:24 Noah awoke from his wine, he knew what (*Ham*) had done to him.

Gen 9:25 said,"Cursed be Canaan...A servant of servants to his brothers."

Gen 9:26 said,"Blessed be The God of Shem; & let Canaan be his servant.

Japheth is blessed by the SEED of the WOMAN (JESUS) through ISRAEL of SHEM

Gen 9:27 "May God enlarge Japheth & let him dwell in the tents of Shem

Gen 9:29 the days of Noah were 965 years & he died.

ONE RACE, THE HUMAN RACE - SHEM, HAM and JAPHETH

Gen 10:1 the records of Shem, Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah

CREATION OF NATIONS TO FULFILL THE COMMAND TO FILL THE EARTH

Gen 11:1 Now the whole earth used the same language and the same words.

Gen 11:2 ...they journeyed east... 3 ...let us make bricks & burn them& they used tar for mortar.

(The first mention of 'tar'... after the Noahic flood - comes from oil!).

Gen 11:4 ...let us build for ourselves a city, and a tower... let us make for ourselves a name, otherwise we will be scattered ...over the face of the whole earth." Gen 11:6 Lord said," ..they are 1 people & have the same language. ...nothing which they purpose to do will be impossible for them. Gen 11:7 Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language

(NOTE, "let Us" go down... Father, Son, and Holy Spirit! cf Gen 1:26.

Man was rebelling against God's command to subdue the earth.)

Gen 11:8 So the Lord scattered them abroad; and they stopped building the city.

PROMISE OF THE LAND, THE SEED, THE PEOPLE; ABRAHAMIC COVENANT

Gen 12:2 And I will make you a great nation, & I will bless you, & make your name great; & so you shall be a blessing;

Gen 12:3 And I will bless those who bless you, & the one who curses you I will curse. & in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

UNCONDITIONAL PROMISE OF THE LAND TO ISRAEL, THE ACTUAL BOUNDARIES:

SABBATH DAY - 7th day (Exodus 20:8-11; Deu 5:12-15) Leviticus 23:3

1) PASSOVER -Leviticus 23:5 1st month, 14th day, @TWILIGHT (evening Gen 1:5)

(note: the Passover lamb was selected on the 10th - Sunday - "Palm Sunday"

Jesus fulfilled this by His death on the cross, FINAL payment for sin.

This took place on "our" Wednesday evening, the THURSDAY NIGHT of Gen 1:5

DAY ONE of Matthew 12:40 (THURSDAY) <http://bibletech.net/TOOLS/Thursday>

2) UNLEAVENED BREAD -Lev 23:6-8 15th day, 7 days - SABBATH FIRST DAY

The year Jesus was crucified: a FRIDAY; leaven = sin, taken to the grave

SABBATH DAY - 7th day (Exodus 20:8-11; Deu 5:12-15) Leviticus 23:3

4) PENTECOST -Lev 23:15-22 (Acts 2:1-47) 7 sabbaths, perpetual statute

Likely the approximate time of the "departure" of the Church, I Cor 15:52

Likely the fulfillment of Zechariah 12/Ezekiel 37, perhaps in the trib.

FULFILLED when JESUS returns - Zechariah 14 & Revelation 19

Ezekiel 40-48 - The 1,000 year Kingdom on earth: Revelation 20; Isa 11 & 65

Ezekiel 44:24 They shall keep ... My appointed feasts & sanctify My sabbaths.

Ezekiel 45:17 at all the appointed feasts of the house of Israel;

THE CHURCH RETURNS WITH JESUS...

Rev 1:6 and He has made us to be a kingdom, priests to His God and Father--to Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. Rev 5:10 "You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth." Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

Leviticus 26 warned Israel if they do not follow the ordinances chapters 23-25 they would be exiled again. Jeremiah and Daniel know they would be 70 years in Babylon for the 490 years they did NOT observe the land Sabbath.

THE PUNISHMENT for failing again was 7x7x7x7 = 2401. They returned from exile around 453 BC

ISRAEL became a nation again in 1948. 2401-1948 ~ 453 BC

*Isaiah 66:8 "Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? **Can a land be born in one day? Can a nation be brought forth all at once?** As soon as Zion travailed, she also brought forth her sons.*

Page 6 - DANIEL: World KINGDOMS, KEY to Understanding the Revelation of Jesus Christ

Major Kingdoms of the earth:

BABYLON, MEDO-PERSIA, GREECE, ROME, revived Rome

(605BC-Nebuchanezzar; 539BC Cyrus; 331BC Alexander the Great)

Babylon -GOLD head (Ch 2)/ Lion (Ch7)

Medo-Persian -SILVER arms & breast(Ch2)/Bear(Ch7)/2 horned Ram(Ch8)

Greece -BRONZE belly & thighs(Ch2)/Leopard(Ch7)/goat(little horn)(Ch8)

Rome -IRON LEGS (Ch2) / Dreadful beast (Ch 7) (146 BC)

~AD33 - Christ's coming -- a gap (Church age) -- Rapture of Church,

the Great tribulation... revived Roman empire in the last days - the feet & 10 toes of iron and clay (Ch 2) /

10 horns (Ch 7)/ the stone cut without hands Christ (Ch 2) / ancient of days (Ch 7)

69 weeks of Daniel's prophecy was fulfilled when Jesus was crucified.

THE REMAINING "WEEK", or period of 7 years is described in the REVELATION.

Daniel 9:24-27 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

Know therefore & understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be 7 weeks and threescore & two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

NOTE: Darius the Mede was most likely "Gubaru - the governor of Babylon and the region beyond the river". (See Nabonidus Chronicle, 539 BC.) Appointed by Cyrus, king of Babylon. Daniel 6 - see "Darius the Mede", John C. Whitcomb, Jr. Th.D. 1979 pg 24. (Prof OT, Grace Theological Seminary, Winona Lake, IN)

The Prophecy of the 70 Weeks (the calculations)

Daniel 9 predicts the day on which Jesus would be presented as Israel's Messiah ("until Messiah the Prince," Daniel 9:25), Palm Sunday, the triumphal entry into Jerusalem on the donkey. The 10th of Nisan that year.

Two reasons why it had to be Nisan 10, **ONE**, that was that the day the Torah specified to select the Passover Lamb, and **TWO**, the Gospels clearly present the events of what we refer to as Palm Sunday as Sunday, and that the Passover as being on the Wednesday afternoon, or the beginning of Thursday evening according to the Jewish day (Genesis 1:5). That would be the 14th of Nisan as clearly defined in Leviticus 23, with the Feast of Unleavened Bread on the 15th of Nisan, a Friday, and then the Sabbath, Saturday the 16th of Nisan, which was the Sabbath according to the commandment.

John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad."

John 8:57 So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?"

John 8:58 Jesus said to them, "**Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I AM.**"

John 8:59 Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple. *(The were going to stone Jesus because He declared Himself to be God...)*

John 8:58 Jesus said,"Truly, truly, I say to you, **before Abraham was born, I AM.**"

Exodus 3:14 God said to Moses, "**I AM WHO I AM**";

and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, '**I AM** has sent me to you.'"

THE LINEAGE OF THE KING - the right to the throne via Joseph & Solomon.

Matthew 1:1 The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham: 2 Abraham was the father of Isaac, Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers.

NOTE: Rahab - the harlot who helped in the capture of Jericho! Ruth, the Gentile wife of Naomi's son, and redeemed by kinsman Boaz, and Bathsheba... who had been the wife of the murdered Uriah!

Mat 1:5 Salmon was the father of Boaz by Rahab, Boaz was the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse. Mat 1:6 Jesse was the father of David the king. David was the father of Solomon by Bathsheba who had been the wife of Uriah. Mat 1:7 Solomon was the father of Rehoboam, Rehoboam the father of Abijah, and Abijah the father of Asa.

Mat 1:16 Jacob was the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, by whom Jesus was born, who is called the Messiah. Mat 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are 14 generations; from David to the deportation to Babylon, 14 generations; and from the deportation to Babylon to the Messiah, 14 generations.

Mat 1:21 She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." Mat 1:22 Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child and shall bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which translated means, "God with us."

THE SEED OF THE WOMAN, THE SEED OF DAVID - THE PROMISE from GENESIS 3:15

THE SON OF NATHAN, - See Zechariah 12; 1Ch 3:5 ...born to him in Jerusalem: Shimea, Shobab, Nathan & Solomon, by Bath-shua the daughter of Ammiel;

Page 9 -Live by FAITH: GRACE & Excellence shared, BELIEVE, RECEIVE, LIVE, LOVE

John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word & the Word was with God & the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

John 1:10-13 He was in the world & the world was made through Him & the world did not know Him. He came to His own & those who were His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born ... of God.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh & dwelt among us & we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 3:3,6 Jesus said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." That which is born of the flesh is flesh & that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

John 3:16=18 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. 18 He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

1Timothy 2:3-6 ...God our Savior, **who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.** For there is **one God**, and **one mediator** also between God and men, the man **Christ Jesus**, who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

2Peter 1:3 seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him **who called us by His own glory and excellence.**

Romans 1:20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher?

Page 10 The DAY OF CHRIST: The departure of the SAINTS & prophecies before the Apocalypse
THE DAY OF CHRIST removes the church, and thus begins the DAY OF THE LORD:

1 Thessalonians 5:1-11 Now as to the times and the epochs, brethren, you have no need of anything to be written to you. For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night. But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that the day would overtake you like a thief; But since we are of the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet, the hope of salvation. 9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, Therefore encourage one another...

John 14:1 "Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. 3 If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also. 4 And you know the way where I am going."

Isaiah 26:20 Come, my people, enter into your rooms And close your doors behind you; Hide for a little while Until indignation runs its course.

1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable & we will be changed. 53 For this perishable must put on the imperishable & this mortal must put on immortality.

1 Thessalonians 4:15-18 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel & with the trumpet of God & the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-24 Rejoice always; pray without ceasing; in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit; do not despise prophetic utterances. But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil. Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; & may your spirit & soul & body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.

2 Thessalonians 2:1-17 ...with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ & our gathering together to Him,...

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy (DEPARTURE) comes first & the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction... And you know what restrains him now, so that in his time he will be revealed. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains will do so until he is taken out of the way.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers...

THE DAY OF THE LORD: The time before the Tribulation described in Revelation chapter 6 through 19, then the 1,000 year reign of Jesus on Earth described in Zechariah 14; Isaiah 11 & 65, Revelation 20,21 & Ezekiel 40-48.

*Jesus describes the Tribulation in **Matthew 24; Luke 21; Mark 13.***

Daniel 12:1 "...there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

IN 1948 ISRAEL RETURNED to their land: Ezekiel 36, 37

Likely Pretribulation conflicts: Isaiah 17, Psalm 83, Jeremiah 49:34

Rev 4 church taken up into heaven, just as John was called up, and as Jesus left (Acts 1:9)

Rev 5 the seals - church will be priests and will reign 1,000 years when we return with Jesus.

Conflict likely the beginning of Jacob's distress (Jeremiah 30:7)

The mention of the burning of weapons for 7 years... Eze 39:9 Ezekiel 38, 39 -

AT THE BEGINNING OF THE TRIBULATION, commencing in Revelation chapter 6:

POPULATION: 8 billion

Rev 6 25% of the WORLD killed- 2 BILLION die - 6 billion remain

White horse – war ; Red horse - remove peace Black horse famine; Ashen horse death

POPULATION: 6 billion

Rev 7 144,000 sealed from the tribes - out of many nations (Zechariah 12) the Jewish witnesses proclaim Jesus around the world, 1.7 cities each. Tribulation saints being martyred.

Rev 8 7th seal - 1/3rd of earth burned - PERHAPS 33% die - down to 4 billion

POPULATION: 4 billion

Rev 9 bottomless pit opened - demons released; 9:16 200 million man army - kills 33% of the world,

POPULATION: 2.7 Billion

Rev 9:20 The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, 21 do NOT REPENT of murders, sorcery, immorality or theft - Abortion/drugs/sexual sins/taxes

Rev 10 no more delays.... book, sweet, but bitter in stomach - must prophesy

Rev 11 2 Witnesses 1,260 days -FINISH testimony, beast makes war, kills them 3.5 days later return to life - 2nd woe - 7k killed in earthquake

end of 1,260 days / mid point MIDPOINT - of the tribulation

Daniel 9:27 he will make a firm covenant for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering;

Rev 12 woman - 12 stars - Israel - Jesus - SPIRITUAL BATTLE -the overview story

The dragon thrown to earth, Israel flees to the wilderness

Rev 13 Dragon -10 horns -7 heads -10 diadems -LEOPARD, feet of BEAR/Lion Mouth

42 months -head wound -midtrib-42 months 42 months more / midpoint mark of beast Rev 13:16, 17; Rev 14:9,11; Rev 16:2; 19:30; 20:4

Rev 14 - 144K witnesses continue, FALLEN is BABYLON - Beast (*church in Rome destroyed by the beast*)

Rev 15 - 7 plagues / 7 angels

Rev 16 - 7 bowls - 16:12 - Euphrates dries up, prepared for the king of the east

Rev 17 - harlot of babylon - 7 mountains - war against the lamb

Rev 18 - Babylon is fallen- Rome is about 10 miles from the sea at the center.

Rev 19 - Bride of Christ / Marriage 19:7 Bride is ready...(last saved arrive)

Zechariah 13,14 19:15 sharp sword. last of the saints, Jesus rtns w/believers

Rev 20 - Satan bound and cast into abyss for 1,000 years.

Page 12 - DAY OF GOD: PAYDAY: The final judgment, The NEW heaven, earth & Jerusalem
During the 1,000 years Jesus fulfills all the Promises Made

PROMISES OF GOD MADE; -PROMISES OF GOD FAITHFULLY FULFILLED

The seed of Woman, Genesis 3:15 - fulfilled in Jesus

The promise of the Land, Genesis 15 - fulfilled in the 1,000 year Kingdom

The promise of the King - fulfilled by Jesus at the cross & in the 1,000 year Kingdom

Then, at the end of the 1,000 years there is the final judgment:

Rev 20:11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

God talked of perpetual, and GOD promised things "forever"... but Revelation 22 doesn't talk about the things promised to Israel, such as land and the perpetual statutes of the Torah...

Lev 23:21 ...It is to be a perpetual statute in all your dwelling places throughout your generations.

It would seem that once the Kingdom showed how it could have been had mankind not fallen into sin after being deceived by Satan, that we will see the New Heaven and New Earth... all things will be new.

THESE PASSAGES seems to show that once the promises are fulfilled in the Kingdom, that many things will no longer be needed:

Psa 89:37 "It shall be established forever like the moon, And the witness in the sky is faithful." Selah.

Rev 21:23 And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp is the Lamb.

Rev 21:1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea. 2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, 4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away." 5 And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true." 6 Then He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost. 7 He who overcomes will inherit these things, and I will be his God and he will be My son. 8 But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."
