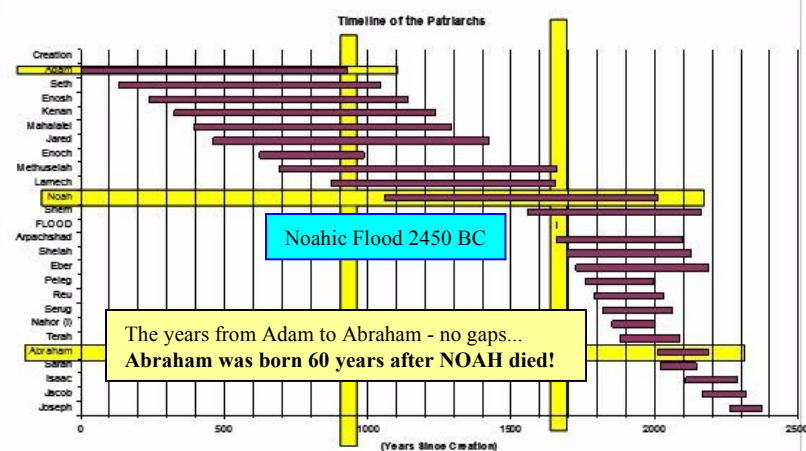

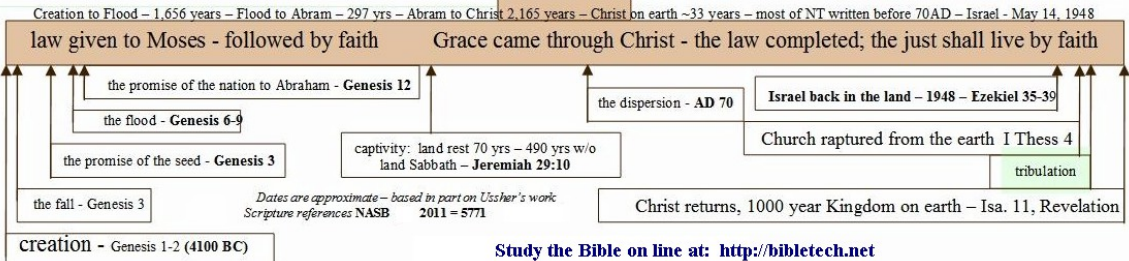

 Preparation day for the Feast of Unleavened Bread - Thursday was not a Sabbath Day
 All the events from the meal through the burial took place before sunset on Thursday, the Passover.
 Luke 23:50-56; John 19:31; Mark 15:37-47

Friday: 15 Nisan - Feast of Unleavened Bread - High Sabbath

NIGHT 1
 Feast of Unleavened Bread; The first day of the feast, Friday, was a day of convocation, a High Sabbath. Leviticus 23:6,7, Joshua 4:19, Matthew 27:62; Mark 15:42

DAY 2

Saturday: 16 Nisan - Sabbath

NIGHT 2
 Sabbath according to the commandment - Leviticus 23:3, Exodus 20:9,10

NIGHT 3
 Jesus rose from the dead before dawn on Sunday, the first day of the week. Matthew 28:1
